### Tasting Notes from the Bishop

Tasting notes often mention “berry undertones” or “hints of chocolate”. They will comment on the finish of the wine or its clarity. I must confess this is not my area of expertise. To me it simply tastes good. I commend this wine to you for several important reasons.

Firstly, it is offered for sale in service of a greater goal – to support the work of God's people in mission and ministry in the WA District of the Lutheran Church. We are thankful to Olive Farm Wines and the Yurisich family for their generous partnership in this fund-raising project.

Secondly, wine in the Scriptures is a sign of God's blessing. From the overflowing cup that is set before the faithful person in Psalm 23, to the vibrant picture of the vine and the branches in John 15, to the “cup of blessing” identified at the table of Holy Communion - our faith is rich with symbols incorporating wine. And since some of the first Lutherans settled in the Barossa Valley and began to cultivate vines, our church has had a long association with the blessing of wine in this country.

At the heart of all this is fellowship. A bottle of wine is made to be shared, at communal table, with warmth and fellowship, with conversation and connection. I am reminded that it was at table that Jesus did much of his most significant work. So my prayer is that in the sharing of this wine, Jesus will be heard saying, “Today I must stay at your house.”

As with all things, wine is not without its challenges. With this in mind I urge you to share these fruits with wisdom and in moderation. In this last year our church has identified the “Hidden Hurts, Healing Hearts” focus on domestic violence as priority work. For too long the misuse of alcohol has fuelled harm. Our call as God's people is to never let anything, even a good thing, lead to evil.

In conclusion may God richly bless the fellowship around your table as you share these fruits of his goodness. May he enrich your daily feast as a reminder of an even greater feast to come – the eternal, heavenly feast.
